Whether you are a student seeking practical experiences or a person planning to rejoin the workforce, our employment and career services can help you. ## The Newfoundland and Labrador Work Information Network (NLWIN)

## Labour Market Supports for Persons with Disabilities

The Labour Market Agreement for Persons with Disabilities (LMA PD) is designed to assist individuals with a disability or vocational challenge acquire the skills, experience and supports necessary to successfully prepare for, enter or remain in the workforce.

LMA PD provides access to employment counselling and assessment, pre-employment training, skills training, technical aids and other supports to help individuals obtain employment. This program is cost-share with Human Resources and Skills Development Canada.

## Community Agency Programs

HRE also supports a number of community agencies that offer employment and career services and can link you to these services. These local programs may vary in specific criteria. To inquire about community programs in your region contact your HRE regional office.

## Wage Subsidy Programs

Wage subsidy programs are available through HRE to assist employers in offering work experience and employment to a variety of individuals. These programs vary in length, duration and type of subsidy. Individuals may utilize these programs in their job search by bringing them to the attention of employers.
