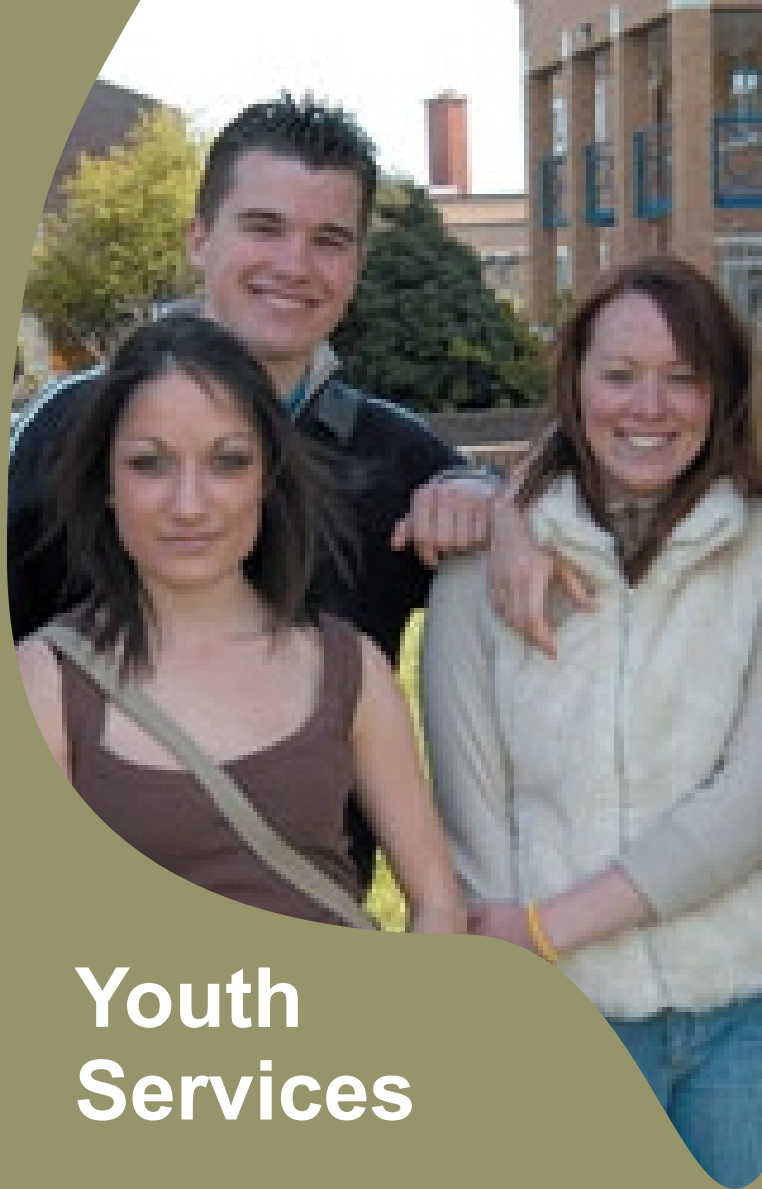

Youth Services

The Career, Employment and Youth Services Division of the Department of Human Resources and Employment develops programs and services all across the province, that help people plan for, find and keep jobs. If you are a youth aged 18-30 and need assistance in planning your career we can help!

Areas of Support

The Career, Employment and Youth Services (CEYS) Division is engaged in a number of activities to help youth develop skills, decide on the right career path as well as find a job while attending school or after graduation. These activities include:

- ✓ Offering employment and career programs;
- ✓ Developing employment and career plans with eligible clients;
- ✓ Partnering with the federal government, other provincial departments and community agencies to develop and deliver programs and services that help people find and maintain jobs;
- ✓ Co-ordinate and deliver labour market adjustment programs; and
- ✓ Help people research, explore and make decisions about careers, training and job options.

With the help of partners, these services are offered throughout communities across the province. This ensures that everyone has equal access to career development resources and job opportunities.

Programs and Services available include:

- ✓ Employment Counseling
- ✓ Labour Market Support for Persons with Disabilities
- ✓ Employment (wage subsidy) Programs
- ✓ Community Partnerships
- ✓ Youth Internships and Job Experience Placements

Clients Eligible for Services

Students (high school and post-secondary) can access youth programs. These programs help youth gain experience, access education supports and receive guidance in career planning.

Youth aged 18-30 who may be planning to enter or rejoin the workforce can use our services.

Career, Employment and Youth Services (CEYS) also has programs in place to assist persons with a physical or mental disability.
